

CHINESE

MAJOR (BA) FOR BRIDGE STUDENTS

Declared Fall 2020 or Later

The Chinese Major requires a minimum of 27 upper-division credits listed under CHIN plus either WLC 2010 or 2020 and a WLC Practicum Signature Experience for a total of **33 credits**. At least 15 credits have to be taken at the University Of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in CHIN 3010 or 3060. For placement into classes, see <https://languages.utah.edu>. Students are encouraged to take WLC 2010 or 2020 before any other upper-division courses in the major and the WLC Practicum Signature Experience (except for Learning Abroad) after all or most of the other courses in the major have been finished. Email wlc-advising@utah.edu if a Required course is not available or a potentially appropriate available course is not listed as an elective.
