MAJOR (BA)

Declared Fall 2024 or Later

The French Major requires a total of **36 credits**. At least 15 credits and all courses 4600 and above must be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete the lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in FRNCH 3040 or 3050. For placement into classes, see <https://languages.utah.edu>. Students are encouraged to take WLC 2010 or 2020 early in the major. Email wlc-advising@utah.edu if a required course is not available or a potentially appropriate available course is not listed as an elective.
