Declared Fall 2020 or Later

The Spanish Teaching Major requires a minimum of **36-39 credits**. At least 15 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete the lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in any upper-division language courses. For placement into classes, see <https://languages.utah.edu>. Email wlc-advising@utah.edu if a required course is not available.
